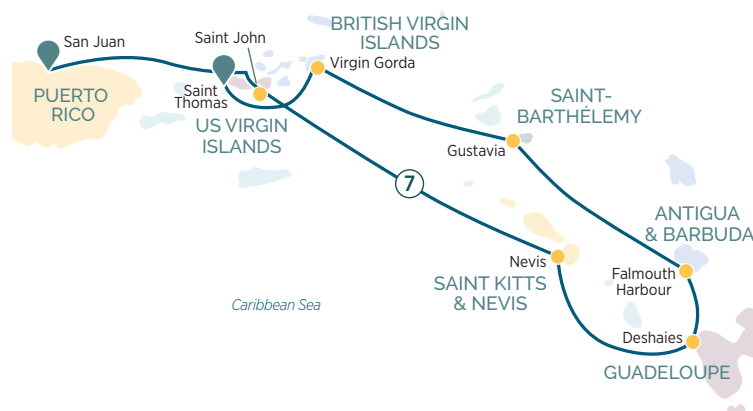

Day 1 Saint Thomas, US Virgin Island

Day 6 Gustavia, Saint Barthélemy

The capital of the lovely Caribbean Island of Saint Barthélemy, Gustavia was named after Sweden's King Gustav III, who boldly declared it his own exclusive island getaway in 1785. In this vibrant city, uncover distinctive treasures in the historic downtown shopping enclave, photograph the brightly painted wooden houses, and feast on unique cuisine that fuses French and Creole culinary influences. **Meals: B, L, D**

Day 7 Prickly Pear Cays, Virgin Gorda, British Virgin Islands

Prickly Pear Cays are a group of small uninhabited islands located off the coast of Virgin Gorda in the British Virgin Islands. These beautiful islands are renowned for their pristine white sandy beaches and crystal-clear turquoise waters. - 121 days or more prior to departure: Deposit Amount
- 120 days until day of departure: 100% of total tour
- No refund on unused portions of the tour

Passport & Visas – Each U.S. citizen must have a valid passport. Expiry date of passports should be at least 6 months after the return date of tour. NOTE: Due to airline security measures, your passport name must match your airline ticket name and your tour reservation name or you may be denied aircraft boarding.
