FRANCE HIGHLIGHTS

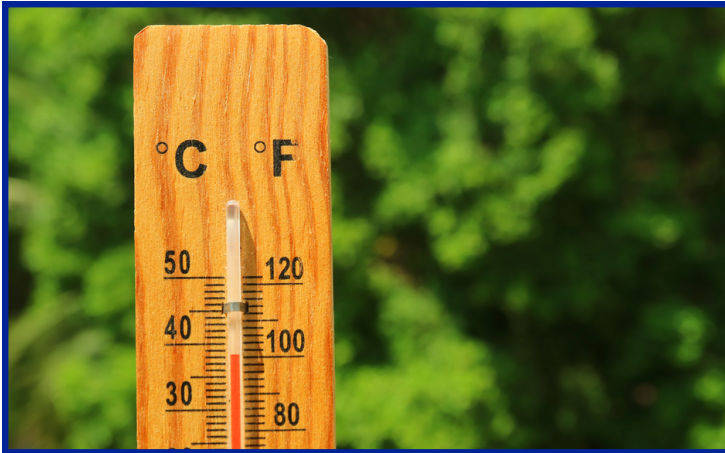
